Buried Bonanza with Vicky December 20, 2024



Vicky Lovejoy was in the first NoseWork class offered at the SPCA in Long Beach when the founders first came up with the idea to offer a version of detection training to pet owners. With the eventual formation of NACSW (National Association of Canine Scent Work), Vicky became a certified NoseWork instructor (CNWI) and ORT judge/certifying official. She is also certified as an AKC Scent Work judge, UKC NoseWork judge/certifying official, USCSS Certifying Official, and currently training as a Certifying Official for NACSW. She has multiple championships on her dogs in NoseWork and, in 2017, competed in the NACSW National Invitational with her Australian Shepherd, Kendra. Kendra has earned two titles in the Summit competitions offered through NACSW for dogs who have completed their Elite Championship. Beryl recently competed in her first Summit trial earning a Summit title and is competing at the Detective level in AKC.

Buried Bonanza 1:00 – 4:00 PM Limit 8 working teams

Buried searches are meant to model conditions that search and rescue dogs might find in the field with locating remains or objects underground or underwater. Our version in bins, with essential oils, and in a range of environments provides complications not seen in a typical search. Handlers often are frustrated by their pass rates and dogs may be confused by the presentation of odor through sand and water.

Teams will have practice, coaching, and feedback on multiple searches including:

- Sand only (Classic novice setup, Varied arrangements, Multiple hides)
- Water only (Classic advanced setup, Varied arrangements)
- Mixed sand and water, with arrangements and hide placement to work:
 - Converging odor, Drifting odor, Sourcing challenges, Handling Strategies
 - Environmental challenges to consider, including: Surfaces, Walls, Airflow, Heat, Cold

Prerequisites: Dogs should be able to source birch, anise and clove; dogs should be able to crate quietly either in the building or outside in your vehicle while waiting their turn
