Vicky Lovejoy was in the first NoseWork class offered at the SPCA in Long Beach when the founders first came up with the idea to offer a version of detection training to pet owners. With the eventual formation of NACSW (National Association of Canine Scent Work), Vicky became a certified NoseWork instructor (CNWI) and ORT judge/certifying official. She is also certified as an AKC Scent Work judge, UKC NoseWork judge/certifying official, USCSS Certifying Official, and currently training as a Certifying Official for NACSW. She has multiple championships on her dogs in NoseWork and, in 2017, competed in the NACSW National Invitational with her Australian Shepherd, Kendra. Kendra has earned two titles in the Summit competitions offered through NACSW for dogs who have completed their Elite Championship. Beryl recently competed in her first Summit trial earning a Summit title and is competing at the Detective level in AKC.

Handler discrimination, lost articles, tracking and many other sports have evolved to use your dog's remarkable sense of smell to find your or another humans odor. This workshop will allow you explore and teach your dog to find your belongings ranging from soft articles, keys, wallets, cell phones, and more! As your dog develops their natural talents, this skill can be useful in your daily life to help you find that elusive thing you put "somewhere!"

Several organizations including AKC, UKC and NASDA offer item location competitions! From a competition standpoint, we will teach both Handler Discrimination (finding YOUR item) and introduce "Matching" (finding another person's item). This workshop will be participant driven, so the needs of your team are met.
