



Vicky Lovejoy was in the first NoseWork class offered at the SPCA in Long Beach when the founders first came up with the idea to offer a version of detection training to pet owners. With the eventual formation of NACSW (National Association of Canine Scent Work), Vicky became a certified NoseWork instructor (CNWI) and ORT judge/certifying official. She is also certified as an AKC Scent Work judge, UKC NoseWork judge/certifying official, USCSS Certifying Official, and currently training as a Certifying Official for NACSW. She has multiple championships on her dogs in NoseWork and, in 2017, competed in the NACSW National Invitational with her Australian Shepherd, Kendra.

Vicky actively competes and judges NASDA events which include: antler shed finding; lost item location; urban locating of rats; and trailing and locating of rats. Her 4 dogs earned Invitational spots in their first year of competition in NASDA. And, 4 Paws Sport Dogs recently hosted our first NASDA event...and we are planning to host more!

## Rat-a-Tat! Intro to Urban Locating 1 pm – 4 PM

## Limit 8 working teams

**Prerequisites**: Dogs need to be crated between their turns and should be able to work around other dogs and people comfortably. Previous search or scentwork **not** required.

NASDA (North American Sport Dog Association – NASDA.dog) offers a rat-finding event in urban locations. Trials are held in and around buildings and dogs search for rats contained within a quarry box.

Dogs will be introduced to the rat in box and value built for finding the rat. Search scenarios similar to those found in a competition environment will be set up for practice. As teams advance in skills, the rat hides become more challenging and may involve height and inaccessibility (as in the trunk of a car). Teams will be appropriately challenged for their level throughout the workshop with the goal of building drive and enthusiasm for the find!
