Vicky actively competes and judges NASDA events which include: antler shed finding; lost item location; urban locating of rats; and trailing and locating of rats. Her 4 dogs earned Invitational spots in their first year of competition in NASDA. Her Vizsla, Phoenix, qualified in all elements & was a finalist in shed hunting.4 Paws Sport Dogs has hosted NASDA events. One is already scheduled the last of May here in the Tri-Cities!

Rat-a-Tat! Urban Locating

Saturday March 22 9 am – Noon

Trials are held in and around buildings and dogs search for rats contained within a quarry box. Dogs will be introduced to the rat in box and value built for finding the rat. Search scenarios similar to those found in a competition environment will be set up for practice. As teams advance in skills, the rat hides become more challenging and may involve height and inaccessibility (as in car trunk).

Rat-a-Tat! Trailing & Locating

Saturday March 22 1 pm – 4 pm

In TL, courses range from 10,000 sq ft to 75,000 sq ft as teams progress in the levels and may involve forested areas, areas dense with brush and include changes in elevation over challenging terrain. A "trail" of rat odor is laid, but dogs may also use air scenting to find their quarry. This workshop will introduce dogs to the concept of tracking via a trail and allow for the finding of quarries in a natural environment. Courses similar to those found in competition will prepare the teams for actual trials.

Where's Bambi? Shed / Antler Find

Sunday March 23 9 am – Noon

Shed hunting is becoming a competitive sport and lucrative pastime for canine teams! Dogs learn to find antlers of several ungulate species! NASDA and UKC both have shed competitions! We will introduce dogs & handlers to the concept of finding shed antlers, work on recognition of the find of antlers, and the search skills involved. Participants will introduce their dogs to and build value for finding antlers! Some exterior searches will be set for practice (weather dependent).

We will also introduce the steps to shape a retrieve of the antler.

Where Are You? Lost Item Recovery

Sunday March 23 1 pm – 4 pm

Both a fun sport and a useful skill!!! Dogs learn to find your items including keys, wallets, phones, credit cards, and articles of clothing.

This workshop will build value for finding items with your scent on them. Dogs will also learn to discriminate your scent from similar items belonging to other individuals. We will set up and play with competition- type settings throughout the facility to give your dog plenty of problem-solving challenges to improve and develop their skills.

NOTE: Prerequisites for all workshops are that dogs are comfortable working around other dogs/people, and are able to be crated quietly when not working.
